- **Defect**: There is a potential for an intermittent steering issue with the autopilot functionality on boats that have both: Joystick Piloting for Outboards with Design 2 Joystick
- Helm steering that has command control module (CCM) calibrated to 6 turns lock-to-lock

Hazard: An unexpected change to the boat's route could lead to a collision and result in injury or death.

What to do:

Design 2 Joystick on your vessel, please contact your Authorised Mercury Marine Dealer who will arrange for the vessel to be inspected to check whether it is affected by this recall and, if so, for the software to be updated to remedy the defect.

The cost of the software update and labor will be covered by Mercury Marine. <u>Do not use the **Route** and **Heading** features in your boat's Design 2 joystick and Multi-Function Display until this is done.</u>
