Defect: The air vents of the affected engine cover may allow for fingers to be placed through the air vent gaps.

Hazard: There is a risk of serious injury including amputation or lacerations to fingers if placed through the air vents. Injuries have occurred because of this hazard.

- 1. Always keep fingers away from the air vents on the engine. Do not use the air vents as a handhold when boarding or departing the boat.
